

Reproduction and Restoration Pricing

Pricing inherently relates to the amount of computer work required to end up with a product that meets your expectations and requirements. As a rule of thumb, I can reproduce five originals which are in reasonably good condition in an hour. Since I charge my time at \$50 per hour, the cost for reproduction would be \$50 or \$10 per image (note there is a minimum charge of \$25). The printing cost is dependent on the size of the print desired. The cost for a single print of your images would be 50% off the normal print price. Additional prints would be at standard pricing.

Estimates will be quoted before any work is started and an authorization for work will need to be returned before work is initiated.

Below is a table of guidelines for reproduction and restoration work; printing charges are not included.

Type of Service	Description	Cost
Reproduction:	This is simply the process of scanning any original, copy or slide. Afterwards, the digital copy can then be changed by applying sepia tones or black and white effects to the image. Simple borders and digital mattes can also be applied.	\$50.00 per hour- \$25.00 minimum charge
Restoration:	Minor- to include correcting exposure or color tone, removal of minor defects such as dust, scratches, and blemishes. This type of work is normally part of the base reproduction.	\$50.00 per hour- \$25.00 minimum charge
	Moderate- any minor adjustments as well as removal of larger scratches and creases, repairing corners, and correcting non-essential background flaws. This type of work can add 15-30 minutes to a reproduction project.	
	Major- any minor or moderate adjustments as well as correcting essential areas in main elements of the photo such as faces, body and clothing or adding missing components. This type of restoration is time consuming and can add up to an hour or more to the reproduction process.
